IT IS DEACON NOMINATION TIME!

*Please keep these things in mind when
Nominating deacons*

- I. A deacon is a church servant, not a church boss.
The word "Deacon" means "Servant". A deacon is elected not to honor a man but to honor and serve God and His church
- II. A Deacon is one whose character is exemplary.
Not only his life, but his reputation is a credit to the church and the Savior. His family life is a good example.
- III. A deacon is a spiritually-minded man.
". . . full of the Holy Spirit," the scriptures say. The world and the deacon cannot mix without the church losing immeasurably
- IV. A deacon is a devoted and faithful steward of his possessions.
A deacon is "not greedy for money." He must lead by his example if the church is to grow a membership of tithers.
- V. A deacon is regular in attendance at all Services.
By his presence he adds much; by his absence he causes much harm. "Not forsaking the gathering of ourselves together."
- VI. A deacon is a soul winner.
His heart's desire should be to see people come to Christ.
- VII. A deacon is the Pastor's Friend.

He should be a counselor, confident, comforter, companion and friend to the pastor.

(Acts 6:1-8 and I Timothy 3:8-13)

- V. 8 Deacons, likewise, should be worthy of respect, not hypocritical, not drinking a lot of wine, not greedy for money.
- V.9 Holding the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.
- V.10 And they must also be tested first; if they prove blameless, then they can serve as deacons.
- V.11 Wives, too, must be worthy of respect, not slanderers. Self-controlled, faithful in everything.
- V.12 Deacons must be husbands of one wife, managing their children and their own households competently.
- V.13 For those who have served well as deacons acquire a good standing for themselves, and great boldness in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.

Hartland Baptist Church utilizes the Deacon Family Ministry Plan. Each deacon who serves Hartland Baptist Church makes a commitment to be responsible for a certain number of families. I.e. ministering to the physical, spiritual and emotional needs of these families.
